



1. Sediment textural analysis (App. B)
2. Dark-gray, slightly muddy, loose, fine sand
3. Dark-gray sandy mud
4. Gray, well-sorted, fine sand
5. Alternating layers of grayish-brown, soft, muddy, very fine to fine sand and sandy muds
6. Brown, soft, cohesive clay with muddy sands at 415 to 418 cm, muddy sands with shell fragments at 439 to 444 cm and 448 to 452 cm
7. Brown, soft mud and sandy mud, shell fragments at 472 to 474 cm, shell fragments and rounded pebbles ( $\leq$  3-cm diameter) at 526 to 549 cm
8. Radiocarbon-14 age date
